All:

In reference to the below link, managed care plans that were awarded contracts under the Managed Medical Assistance component of the Statewide Medicaid Managed Care program are required to cover services for all children in unlimited amounts and duration, whenever medically necessary. All children will have access to certified and trained choice counselors, who will be available to educate families on their managed care plan choices and assist them with enrollment. Choice counselors will arrange face-to-face visits for recipients with special needs in their home or in the community, upon request. Managed Medical Assistance plans have agreed to provide enhanced care coordination for medically complex children and are required to have an adequate network of providers to meet the needs of their enrollees.
