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June Monthly Actions: Agency Took Licensure Action against 18 Providers, Seven Additional Providers Terminated from the Medicaid Program

Tallahassee, Fla.—The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) issued final orders to 18 providers for failure to meet licensure requirements during the month of June. The Agency issued three final orders to deny a license renewal application, 13 to revoke an existing license, and two that resulted in the providers surrendering their license. Some of these providers were enrolled in the Medicaid program; however, the Agency has terminated or is in the process of terminating their participation in the program.

Seven additional providers were issued a final order terminating them from participation in the Medicaid program in June. These terminations resulted from sanctions imposed for failing to reimburse Agency within the timeframes established by the Agency, termination from Medicare/Medicaid program, and for pleading guilty to conspiracy to commit healthcare fraud. These providers also have been reported to the federal government for placement on the federal exclusion list, which prohibits them from participating in Medicaid and Medicare nationwide.
