Week Three Hospital COVID-19 Vaccine Allocation

Week 3 Hospital Allocations

The Department of Health (DOH) will be finalizing Week 3 (1/4/21) hospital COVID-19 allocations based on hospitals fully enrolled as of 10:00 a.m. Friday, December 18th as a COVID-19 Provider through DOH's Immunization Section. To start the enrollment process, visit the SHOTS website at www.flshots.com. Week 3 allocations will be made to hospitals that were not allocated in Week 1 (12/14/20) or Week 2 (12/21/20). Hospitals that are not enrolled by the Week 3 deadline may continue the enrollment process and will be eligible for direct allocation in future weeks.

SHOTS Shipping Information

To ensure that COVID-19 vaccine orders are received and promptly entered into inventory, it is important that the ordering site shipping address match the address provided in their Section B within SHOTS. Avoiding any discrepancies in the accuracy of the shipping address will prevent vaccine deliveries to be lost, wasted, become non-viable or returned to the supplier.

The Section B Provider Profile Form captures information found in Florida SHOTS for the site, and asks for additional site-specific information. The primary contact on the account must submit the Section B form in Florida SHOTS. Please verify the shipping address and contact information as listed in the Section B form prior to submission.
