Vaccine Allocation Request Process for Long-Term Care Providers

The Florida Department of Health and the Agency for Health Care Administration are working together to streamline the vaccine allocation request process for providers. Moving forward, **the Agency for Health Care Administration will no longer submit the request for you.**

Effective Monday, April 12, 2021, all long-term care providers must work with your contracted pharmacy who will request the necessary allocation through the Florida SHOTS system. The pharmacies should submit their requests by noon each Wednesday in order to receive vaccines the following week. Order status and shipping information can be tracked in Florida SHOTS.

For the week of April 19, 2021, requests for vaccine allocation **must be submitted by Wednesday, April 14, 2021 at 12 p.m.**
