COVID-19 Hospital Vaccine and Therapeutics Information

Governor DeSantis Executive Order

Today, Governor DeSantis signed an [Executive Order](#) directing prioritization of vaccinations in Florida. Hospitals receiving/administering COVID-19 vaccine allocations must comply with the Order.

Supplies to Support Additional Pfizer Doses

Given the extra doses available in the Pfizer vials you may need to print additional vaccination cards, which are available [here](#). If additional supplies are needed, please try to obtain from your suppliers, however, if you are unable to do so, you may submit a request through your county emergency management agency at <https://www.floridadisaster.org/counties>.

Moderna Allocations to Hospitals

Hospitals receiving Moderna allocations this week are based on the total staff entered in [ESS](#) for staff who have BOTH high risk and low risk exposure, plus 15%.

Vaccine Transfers

If there is a need to transfer COVID-19 vaccines from your inventory to another site within your organization or to another Vaccines For Children (VFC) provider outside of your organization please follow the Department of Health (DOH) [Transferring COVID-19 Vaccine Inventory](#) guidelines.

Vaccination Reporting

SHOTS: Please continue to report your facility's administration of COVID-19 vaccines into the DOH SHOTS system by 9PM each evening but no later than 24 hours after administration.

ESS: Please ensure you are also reporting the number of staff vaccinated into the AHCA Emergency Status System (ESS) Add'l Info tab **daily** by 10 AM ET until further notice. If you require additional assistance with ESS, please contact your AHCA licensing unit, Hospital & Outpatient Services Unit, at 850-412-4549.

Federal Hospital Reporting of Therapeutics

To properly monitor use of COVID-19 therapeutic provided to Florida hospitals, all hospitals must report use in the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) TeleTrack (NHSN) system. The specific questions include weekly updates for:

- 39a. Current inventory on hand Casirivimab/Imdevimab
- 39b. Courses used in the last week Casirivimab/Imdevimab
- 39c. Current inventory on hand Bamlanivimab
- 39d. Courses used in the last week Bamlanivimab

Please ensure this federal information is added for prior weeks and updated weekly for your hospital.
