Curative Testing for Intermediate Care Facilities for the Developmentally Disabled Staff Ending September 30, 2020

Effective September 30, 2020, the Agency will not enforce Emergency Rule 59AER20-7 requiring biweekly staff testing for intermediate care facilities for the developmentally disabled. The state contract with Curative for intermediate care facility staff testing will end on September 30, 2020. Test specimens must be mailed (post marked) to Curative **on or before September 30th** to be processed under the state contract. All unused test kits should be shipped to the Florida Division of Emergency Management at 2555 Shumard Oak Blvd, Tallahassee, FL 32399.
