. NOTICE OF MEDICAID CONTINUATION

You may have gotten a letter that your Medicaid was ending or that your enrollment in a Medicaid health plan was ending. **This is to notify you that your Medicaid coverage has been extended and you are still eligible for Medicaid.**

The State of Florida is taking this step to make sure that people on Medicaid keep benefits during the COVID-19 state of emergency.

Your coverage will continue until the end of the state of emergency. You will get a letter before your coverage will end.

You do not need to do anything to keep your Medicaid. Your benefits will remain the same.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Will my current gold card still work?

Answer: Yes, your gold card will still work.

2. Will my current plan ID card still work?

Answer: Yes, your plan ID card will still work.

3. How will I know how long I have Medicaid?

Answer: At a minimum, you will have Medicaid through the end of the state of emergency. You will get a letter before your Medicaid ends.

4. What type of notice will I get when this ends?

Answer: You will get a letter in the mail.

5. Do I get full coverage?

Answer: You will keep the same kind of Medicaid you have now.

6. Will I keep my same Medicaid health plan?

Answer: Yes, you will stay in the same plan.

7. Do I still have my dental plan?

Answer: Yes, everyone who has dental benefits will keep their same dental plan.
