Re: Suspension of the Long-term Care Level of Care Report and Nursing Facility Transfer Report

The purpose of this policy transmittal is to notify the Comprehensive Long-term Care (LTC) plans that the requirements to submit the LTC Level of Care and Nursing Facility Transfer reports are suspended. Following receipt of this policy transmittal, the Comprehensive LTC plans are not required to submit these reports to the Agency for Health Care Administration.
