## Statewide Medicaid Managed Care (SMMC) Policy Transmittal

- Managed Medical Assistance Specialty Plan
- Children's Medical Services Network (CMSN) Plan

### Re: Third Party Liability Reporting

Managed care plans must determine the legal liability of third parties to pay for services rendered to enrollees under their contracts and notify the Agency of any third party liability (TPL) discovered. (Attachment II, Section X.D.1.a.<sup>1</sup>) The managed care plans must transmit to the Agency or its agent, in a periodicity schedule, format and data exchange method to be determined by the Agency, specific data the health plan may garner from an enrollee, including TPL data. (Attachment II, Section VIII.C.3.h.(3)<sup>2</sup>) The purpose of this policy transmittal is to notify the managed care plan that TPL reporting to the Agency's contracted TPL vendor, Health Management Systems, Inc., is suspended until further notice.
