Re: Healthy Behaviors Report Guide Chapter Revision

The managed care plan must submit a quarterly report on its Healthy Behaviors programs in accordance with Section XIV Reporting Requirements and the Managed Care Plan Report Guide. (Attachment II, Exhibit II-A, Section XIV.A.¹) The purpose of this policy transmittal is to notify managed care plans of a clarification to the Healthy Behaviors Report.

Beginning with the managed care plan's report submission on April 15, 2017 for the reporting quarter January 2017 through March 2017, the managed care plan will report only newly enrolled individuals in Healthy Behaviors programs for each reporting quarter. Quarterly reporting of enrollee participation in Healthy Behaviors programs must be unduplicated throughout the year.
