Re: Annual PIP Submission

The Statewide Medicaid Managed Care Contract requires the managed care plan to submit ongoing Performance Improvement Projects (PIP) annually by August 1 to the Agency for review and approval. (Attachment II, Section VII.C.3.a.¹) The managed care plan is also required to submit the Agency-approved PIP validation form to the External Quality Review Organization (EQRO) upon its request for validation. (Attachment II, Section VII.C.3.c.²) The purpose of this policy transmittal is to inform managed care plans that the annual PIP submission is not required to be submitted to the Agency by August 1, 2018. The managed care plan will also not be required to submit the PIP to the EQRO for the remainder of this contract term.
