The tables below provide a break out of data for residents in civil state mental health treatment facilities who are placed pursuant to Chapter 394, F.S., or Chapter 916, F.S. The department has the ability to adjust the bed capacities for these populations based on statewide need/demand. It is not uncommon for step-down and Baker Act capacities to be adjusted throughout the year based on number of individuals awaiting placement. However, the total number of beds at the facility is not impacted by these fluctuations.
